Local Rules – 2023 CMMC

- Format
 - Various Formats will be used for the Men's Club Events. Please check master schedule and Golf Genius invite for details for the weekly games.
- Ties
 - Ties will be decided by the USGA recommended tie breaker.
- Teeing Area
 - Teeing areas will be assigned on the tee sheet for the event. The event invite will indicate if the player can play another teeing area.
- Tee Times
 - Tee times will be indicated on the tee sheet distributed with the event details. Players that are late to the tee area as indicated by the CMGC clock at the first tee will be assessed a 2-STROKE PENALTY on the first hole. The player is DISQUALIFIED if they are more than 5 minutes late for their assigned tee time.
- When the Competition Is Final
 - o The competition is final when the "Results" email is sent to the CMMC distribution.
- Pace of Play
 - Each group is expected to finish their round in 4 hours, 20 minutes. The bottom of your scorecard shows the expected finish time for each hole, based on your start time. Please monitor this time and your position on the course.
- Local Rule For Alternative Stroke And Distance
 - Camas Meadows Men's Club WILL NOT use the USGA local rule for out of bounds/lost ball. If you believe that your ball may be OUT OF BOUNDS or LOST OUTSIDE OF A PENALTY AREA, please play a provisional ball under rule 18.3. A ball that is known to be lost or out of bounds and not played under the stroke and distance provisions of rule 18 is considered a serious breach of rule 18.2 with a penalty of DISQUALIFICATION for the event. If your original ball is found in the general area or in a penalty area, the provisional ball MUST be abandoned and play must continue with the original ball.
- Penalty Areas
 - PENALTY AREAS are marked by either red or yellow stakes. The edge of the PENALTY AREA is defined by the mown edge of the long grass and the rough.
- No Play Zones
 - All penalty areas that have a green painted top are NO PLAY ZONES and must take penalty relief. The penalty for playing a ball from the NO PLAY ZONE is the GENERAL PENALTY in breach of 17.1(e)
 - The area of long grass that contains the newly planted trees between hole 6 (across the bridge on the right side) and the right side of hole 7 is a **NO PLAY ZONE**. Play is **PROHIBITED** from this area. If it is known or virtually certain that the ball is in the **NO PLAY ZONE**, the player MUST take penalty relief for the red penalty area. Please see rule 17.1 for relief procedure.
